Comment posters and Loon Commons blog authors shall not use any portion of MEP's online outlets for posting, emailing, transmitting or otherwise making available content that is harassing, harmful, threatening, abusive, vulgar, obscene, defamatory, libelous, hateful, or racially, ethnically or otherwise objectionable or harmful to minors in any way.
3. Comment posters and Loon Commons blog authors shall not use any portion of MEP's online outlets for posting, emailing, transmitting or otherwise making available junk mail, commercial advertisements, or any other form of commercial solicitation.
